### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

1. Complete application form. If space is not adequate, attach additional page(s).
2. Attach a 300-word essay explaining why you selected your field of study and sharing your thoughts about working at Tillamook PUD. Indicate your commitment to employment during your breaks at college or vocational school.
3. Attach a minimum of three (3) letters of recommendation; one from a school counselor or administrator, one from an employer (if applicable), and one letter should be a personal reference (excluding school officials or family members).
4. Attach a copy of your most current high school transcripts.
5. Submit completed application and supporting documents to the attention of Employment for Education; Tillamook PUD; PO Box 433, Tillamook, OR 97141.

Applications must be received by **5 p.m., Friday, April 3, 2009.**

6. In mid-April, you will receive a call to schedule a 20-minute interview with Tillamook PUD's Board of Directors.

**JOB DESCRIPTION**

Students will perform varied tasks normal to the operation of an electric utility including outside work such as flagging and chipping brush. Students will receive training and flagging certification required for assisting line crews and right-of-way clearing crews. Inside work may include answering phones, assisting customers, and data input.

**APPLICANT MUST:**

- Be a U.S. citizen and a resident of Tillamook PUD's service area;
- Be at least 17 years old, a graduating senior with a minimum grade point average of 3.0. High school studies must have included two years of mathematics beyond Algebra I and two years of science, including biology;
- Be accepted at an accredited college to attain a two or four-year degree and attend school full-time; or be accepted into a vocational program for certification in a specialized field and attend school full-time; and maintain grades to satisfy college/vocational school requirements;
- Commit to working for Tillamook PUD during spring, summer, and winter breaks;
- Comply with Tillamook PUD's employee policies or be subject to dismissal from the program;
- Have a valid driver's license;
- Have ability to perform manual labor;
- Pass a physical capacity test and drug screening;
- Submit verification of grades to Nancy Dillard within one month after the end of each term to remain in the program.

Failure to attend school or comply with these requirements terminates the student from the program.

- Tillamook PUD Board of Directors will interview applicants and select a winner.
- Applicants will be evaluated on:

- The Board of Directors selects the award recipient.
- The Board of Directors selects an alternate in case the winner does not complete the program.
