



2010 Community Support Grant Program

Tillamook PUD is offering a Community Support Grant program to local non-profit organizations with projects that promote economic growth and community livability in Tillamook County. Projects must be planned for completion by the end 2010.

Who May Apply?

Any officer or authorized person representing a **not-for-profit entity** in Tillamook County

Where Do I Get An Application?

Applications are available at Tillamook PUD or on-line at www.tpud.org.

Application Deadline

Organizations must submit a complete application to Tillamook PUD no later than Friday, February 19, 2010. Submit one application that can be copied – **do not staple or bind the application**. (If there are additional documents other than 8½ x 11 paper, please submit 13 sets.)

Evaluation Process

The Tillamook PUD Board of Directors will evaluate the applications and select grant recipients. The following are among the considerations for award selection:

- economic development potential
- outreach into community
- project completion by end of calendar year 2010
- need

When Will You Select Recipients?

The PUD Board of Directors will select grant recipients at a meeting to be announced in March 2010. All applicants will be notified by Tillamook PUD after selections are made.

Specific Grant Information to Note

- Individual grants shall not exceed \$10,000.
- Grants will not be awarded to the same entity more than twice in a five-year period.
- Grant funds will be paid upon project completion.
- Funds paid will not exceed final project cost.

Monitoring

- Organizations who are awarded funds agree to submit regular progress reports to Tillamook PUD and agree that PUD personnel may perform intermittent review or on-site project inspections.
- Upon project completion, verification of costs and a final report must be submitted to Tillamook PUD.

Tillamook PUD supports the communities it serves and the efforts of not-for-profit organizations to promote economic growth within Tillamook County. The PUD will support those efforts through in-kind and financial contributions and within the confines of its ability and the law.
